Diking is a great option for getting to campus. No bike? No worries! All faculty & staff have <u>unlimited 30-minute rides</u> through our partnership with Healthy Ride, Pittsburgh's local bike share company.

Outdoor <u>bicycle parking</u> is available throughout campus. For <u>secure bicycle parking</u>, bike lockers are available for rent, or you can request access to an indoor bike room. Register your bicycle on the <u>Pitt BikeIndex!</u>

Vanpooling is the most affordable commuting option for many faculty & staff. Participants – typically 5 to 12 people – share a ride and split the cost of commuting to campus. Vanpools are available through our partnership with CommuteInfo and Commute with Enterprise. Vehicles range from Minivans to SUVs to 12-15 passenger vans. Pitt vanpools qualify for reduce permit fees, an emergency ride home program, and more!





Carpooling to campus with 1 to 4 co-workers saves you money and is better for the environment! Registering your carpool is easy! If your carpool has a Pitt parking permit you'll qualify for a parking discount, complimentary day parking passes, and more!

Of Driving Alone and parking on campus requires a Pitt parking permit or paying a daily rate. Faculty & staff interested in obtaining a Pitt parking permit can apply for up to 3 waitlists and must wait to be offered a permit. Parking on campus is very limited and most faculty & staff will wait several years before being offered a permit.

ParkMobile reservations are available on a first-come, first-served basis for faculty & staff who intermittently require parking on campus. Daily rates vary by location. Reservations should be made a few days in advance through the "ParkMobile" app, online or by calling 866-330-7275.
